

## STRATEGIC PLAN 2021
















## Strategic Objectives

The Alliance Strategic Objectives have been developed as medium to long term focus areas that will contribute to being able to deliver on our Priorities and Goals. These objectives have been developed to ensure the continued growth, success and sustainability of the Environment & Waterways Alliance.

These Strategic Objectives are focus areas for delivery over the period of this Strategic Plan and will be achieved through the delivery of component tasks to be outlined in the Annual Alliance Operational Plans. Our Strategic Objectives are:

- Ensure the long-term viability of the
  Environment & Waterways Alliance by
  thoroughly reviewing the financial status of the
  group, membership base and membership
  agreements prior to new Terms of Reference and
  Membership Agreements being issued to Member
  Councils
- Delivery of all grant funded projects to a high standard in order to improve environmental outcomes across the region, and to increase the chances of success during future grant funding rounds

- Pursue grant funding for major Alliance projects through various sources including the NSW Environmental Trust, while supporting smaller Member Council led projects through assistance with grant applications and project development
- Maintain and enhance existing partnerships with other environmental groups, agencies and organisations, and further seek new partnerships where environmental benefits can be delivered
- Actively work to ensure that Alliance communications are timely, professional and factually based
